$$\frac{2}{9} \times \frac{9}{7} = \frac{2}{7}$$

$$\frac{10}{13} \times \frac{4}{14} = \frac{20}{91}$$

$$\frac{3}{7} \times \frac{7}{14} = \frac{3}{14}$$

$$\frac{12}{3} \times \frac{5}{2} = \frac{10}{1}$$

$$\frac{13}{12} \times \frac{14}{7} = \frac{13}{6}$$

$$\frac{4}{14} \times \frac{5}{7} = \frac{10}{49}$$

$$\frac{9}{8} \times \frac{15}{13} = \frac{135}{104}$$

$$\frac{10}{14} \times \frac{10}{13} = \frac{50}{91}$$

$$\frac{7}{4} \times \frac{15}{8} = \frac{105}{32}$$

$$\frac{2}{4} \times \frac{4}{12} = \frac{1}{6}$$

$$\frac{5}{7} \times \frac{3}{15} = \frac{1}{7}$$

$$\frac{6}{11} \times \frac{13}{12} = \frac{13}{22}$$

$$\frac{14}{6} \times \frac{12}{3} = \frac{28}{3}$$
