$$\frac{14}{6} \times \frac{10}{7} = \frac{10}{3}$$

$$\frac{12}{3} \times \frac{10}{8} = \frac{5}{1}$$

$$\frac{8}{12} \times \frac{14}{6} = \frac{14}{9}$$

$$\frac{13}{9} \times \frac{15}{4} = \frac{65}{12}$$

$$\frac{15}{8} \times \frac{13}{10} = \frac{39}{16}$$

$$\frac{11}{12} \times \frac{14}{10} = \frac{77}{60}$$

$$\frac{4}{5} \times \frac{3}{13} = \frac{12}{65}$$

$$\frac{14}{5} \times \frac{2}{7} = \frac{4}{5}$$

$$\frac{10}{4} \times \frac{12}{8} = \frac{15}{4}$$

$$\frac{11}{2} \times \frac{14}{5} = \frac{77}{5}$$

$$\frac{7}{11} \times \frac{10}{5} = \frac{14}{11}$$

$$\frac{6}{9} \times \frac{5}{12} = \frac{5}{18}$$

$$\frac{12}{7} \times \frac{13}{3} = \frac{52}{7}$$

$$\frac{8}{9} \times \frac{13}{10} = \frac{52}{45}$$
