$$\frac{2}{11} \times \frac{14}{12} = \frac{7}{33}$$

$$\frac{9}{13} \times \frac{10}{2} = \frac{45}{13}$$

$$\frac{13}{7} \times \frac{6}{9} = \frac{26}{21}$$

$$\frac{9}{2} \times \frac{12}{9} = \frac{6}{1}$$

$$\frac{11}{12} \times \frac{3}{6} = \frac{11}{24}$$

$$\frac{12}{13} \times \frac{2}{6} = \frac{4}{13}$$

$$\frac{9}{8} \times \frac{9}{10} = \frac{81}{80}$$

$$\frac{12}{14} \times \frac{13}{5} = \frac{78}{35}$$

$$\frac{13}{10} \times \frac{11}{7} = \frac{143}{70}$$

$$\frac{3}{8} \times \frac{4}{11} = \frac{3}{22}$$

$$\frac{4}{12} \times \frac{10}{3} = \frac{10}{9}$$

$$\frac{7}{10} \times \frac{2}{7} = \frac{1}{5}$$

$$\frac{7}{6} \times \frac{7}{15} = \frac{49}{90}$$

$$\frac{3}{14} \times \frac{11}{3} = \frac{11}{14}$$
