$$\frac{4}{12} \times \frac{3}{9} = \frac{1}{9}$$

$$\frac{4}{3} \times \frac{3}{4} = \frac{1}{1}$$

$$\frac{8}{2} \times \frac{6}{13} = \frac{24}{13}$$

$$\frac{14}{13} \times \frac{6}{11} = \frac{84}{143}$$

$$\frac{9}{7} \times \frac{14}{4} = \frac{9}{2}$$

$$\frac{3}{2} \times \frac{11}{9} = \frac{11}{6}$$

$$\frac{15}{10} \times \frac{10}{5} = \frac{3}{1}$$

$$\frac{11}{8} \times \frac{3}{9} = \frac{11}{24}$$

$$\frac{10}{7} \times \frac{4}{14} = \frac{20}{49}$$

$$\frac{6}{13} \times \frac{5}{8} = \frac{15}{52}$$

$$\frac{3}{9} \times \frac{7}{13} = \frac{7}{39}$$

$$\frac{12}{14} \times \frac{14}{2} = \frac{6}{1}$$

$$\frac{11}{8} \times \frac{13}{15} = \frac{143}{120}$$
